Voter Registration Campaign: Making Your List

We are trying to find people who live in Wisconsin and need to register or register to vote. People who had a name change, recently moved, or have not voted in 4 years will need to re-register. Who do you know that you could call or have a conversation with?

Tapping Your Social Network: Where to Find People to Register

- Don't assume people are registered
- Family
- Friends
- Someone who just moved.
 - o Anyone new in your building or on your block?
 - Someone who just moved into senior living.
 - Someone who rents and moves frequently
- Someone age 18 21. Recent high school grads. College students
- Someone who is recently "off paper"
- Ask the people you're interacting with
 - The person who delivers your groceries or your packages
 - Your barber or hairdresser
 - The receptionist at the doctor's office
 - The people who clean your house
 - Your mail carrier
 - The check-out clerk at the store
 - Other passengers on the bus
 - o The plumber or repair person or handyman
 - Your clients, your patients, your customers, your co-workers. Who are the people you talk to as part of your job or volunteer work?
- What are the groups you belong to?
- → Ask the people you know if THEY know someone who might need to register.

In addition to your social network, we also want to make sure we contact every member of your congregation or organization. Your GOTV Captain will hold a virtual team meeting to check in and to divide the list of members in your organization. We are asking you to add those folks to your list of people to call.
